AN EMERGENCY ORDINANCE DESIGNATING CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO SIGN DOCUMENTS AND ADMINISTER OATHS IN THE ABSENCE OF A MAYOR UNTIL SUCH TIME AS A MAYOR IS APPOINTED BY THE COUNCIL

RECITALS

- 1. That the Mayor of the City of Hagerstown Emily N. Keller has resigned as of 11:59 p.m. on January 31, 2023. The Council is in the process of appointing a new Mayor pursuant to the City Charter.
- 2. Certain documents need to be signed and certain oaths need to be administered before a new Mayor can be appointed and the current City Charter or Code makes no provisions for these duties.
- 3. That the City Council desires to designate Scott A. Nicewarner, the City Administrator to perform these duties until a new Mayor is appointed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Hagerstown:

- 1. That the recitals in this Ordinance are incorporated by reference herein and deemed a substantive part of this Ordinance.
- 2. That the City Administrator Scott A. Nicewarner is hereby designated to execute all documents on behalf of the City of Hagerstown, required to have been executed by the Mayor and is further authorized to administer all oaths normally administered by the Mayor.
- 3. That an emergency exists, under the City's Charter at Article II, Section 207, because of the resignation of the Mayor and the need to have documents executed and oaths administered in the time period before a new Mayor can be appointed. It is necessary that this Ordinance become effective immediately upon passage by the Council.
