

Thank you Michelle – we had numerous valve issues which we will be working through to determine the best path forward. We were not able to start the actual repair until 2:30am because of valve issues (15-hours to work valves). Collection crews are working now to repair a storm drain that was found during the water main work – we had to acquire an emergency permit from CSX to repair the main and want to make the permanent repair to the storm under this permit.

Once I know how we are going to move forward with the valve work, I will follow-up. We had to shut down the main between Chicks Seafood and the Dead-End Tavern as well as numerous valves on the side streets because of the valve issues

Michelle – I am requesting emergency authorization to make emergency repairs to the transmission main on Summit. We had one valve fail at Summit and Reynolds that will require emergency replacement. This repair will include materials but could also require assistance from Hetzer or Belt. At this time, I am not certain what else might be needed but will update once we know more.

Scott and I discussed and he is fine with whatever is needed to restore the water system. Should the cost be \$10,000 or more, I will prepare a consent agenda for January.
