A RESOLUTION TO APPROVE PROPERTY OWNER REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH SURREY, LLC

RECITALS

WHEREAS, as part of its overall Stormwater Protection Program, the City of Hagerstown, Maryland ("City") offers reimbursement to property owners for qualifying large-scale stormwater management or impervious area reduction that improve the quality of stormwater runoff through its Large-Scale Incentive Program; and

WHEREAS, on or about September 12, 2022, Surrey, LLC ("Surry") applied to participate in the Large-Scale Incentive Program for stormwater and water quality facilities improvements at its property located at 535 Summit Avenue, Hagerstown, Maryland; and

WHEREAS, Surrey's proposed stormwater and water quality facilities exceed the requirements of City's Stormwater Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the City will be able to take credit for Surrey's proposed stormwater and water quality facilities in meeting the City's MS4 permit requirements; and

WHEREAS, Surrey seeks reimbursement in the amount of Sixty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$65,357.00), which is one-half of the cost of Surrey's proposed stormwater and water quality facilities that exceed the requirements of the City's Stormwater Ordinance; and

WHEREAS the Mayor and Council believe it to be in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Hagerstown to enter into the Property Owner Reimbursement Agreement;

NOW THERFORE, **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Hagerstown, Maryland, as its duly constituted legislative body, as follows:

- 1. That the foregoing Recitals be and are hereby incorporated herein as if set forth verbatim.
- 2. That the reimbursement to Surrey in the amount of Sixty-Five Thousand Three Hundred Fifty-Seven Dollars (\$65,357.00) pursuant to the terms and conditions of the Property Owner Reimbursement Agreement be and is hereby approved.
- 3. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized to execute and deliver the Property Owner Reimbursement Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

That City Staff be and are hereby authorized to execute and deliver any additional 4. documentation and take any additional steps necessary to effectuate the purpose of this Resolution and satisfy the terms of the Property Owner Reimbursement Agreement.
